

Message from H.H. Most Venerable Mahasaddhammajuthikadhaja 13th Sangharaja Dr. Jnananshree Mahathera in brief



DhammachakkaPavattana Sutta is the first teaching delivered by Lord Buddha after he attained enlightenment. The Blessed one's audience consisted of five ascetics who had been his former companions Kondanna, Assaji, Bhaddiya, Vappa and Mahanama.

The essence of Buddhism has been explained in this sutta, especially the four noble truth, the noble eightfold path, the middle way, the twelve insights of the four noble truths, proclamation of release from the cycle of rebirth, the opening of the Dhamma.

The Buddhist world pays homage to the Buddha for setting in motion the wheel of Dhamma. Dhammachakka, it is a Buddhist symbol that conveys the direction of teaching in the path of knowledge of the intellect.

Now a days, chanting this sutta has gradually been started in Bangladesh. Earlier only monks at temple used to recite this sutta on full moon day of Buddhist lent period, now its scope has been increased. Lay devotees along with monks have also become interested in reading this sutta.

I would like to invite everyone to chant DhammachakkaPavattana Sutta for the benefits of oneself as well welfare of society.
